
My mother tells me I'm a hoarder. But I like to think of myself as a magpie.

Other things are most recent.








... a ring bought to replace another much prettier than the first and infinitely more precious to me

... a honeybee for someone that makes my life sweeter.


But whatever they may be, they're precious to me.


Objects & idea

Scene 1- Room




- Objects are displayed around the room and in wardrobe that acts as display.
- Different coloured lights denote different emotions. Pink for love, Yellow for joy and Blue-Green for nostalgia.
- Camera moves around the room and across the display before zooming into a photograph of a temple on the cork board that acts as a portal to the next scene.

Scene 2- The Temple of Memory




• Looking at traditional storytelling techniques in India- sculptures in temples as a form of storytelling

Scene 2- The Temple of Memory



- Objects are displayed through sculptures and reliefs on columns and walls
- In the sanctum, a magpie sits in a nest made of the objects- indicating comfort and security
- Camera moves around the temple in a straight fashion at first and then goes around the sanctum in a circumambulatory path before entering the sanctum and revolving around the 'deity'

Scene 3- Loop back to Room



- Camera shoots up from the sanctum and revolves around the temple spire before zooming into one of the birds at the top of the spire
- This scene then zooms out to the bird in the tree outside the room before panning to the room
